
• CONSTITUTIONAL AND SOCIAL GUARANTEE THROUGH EQUAL OPPORTUNITY


• HUMAN RIGHTS DAY CELEBRATION

In commemoration of Human Rights day, the Centre for Human rights and Democracy and Department of Political science and Economics in association with IQAC, has organized one day seminar on" Freedom, Equality and Justice for all" on December 11 2023, at seminar hall, Sreenarayana College, Nattika. The resource person was Dr. Prasad M.V, Asst. Prof & HOD Department of Political Science, Sreekrishna College, Guruvayur. Human rights day's significance in the current context was brought up at the beginning of the discussion. In particular, he provided an overview of the history and foundation of human rights both globally and within the context of India. He shed light on the Magna Carta, the Bill of Rights, and the origins of each word used in the seminar from a global viewpoint. He also discussed the contributions made by American and European counterparts to the creation of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and its development. India finalized its Constitution at the same time as the UNHR was enacted. Additionally, the Indian Constitution was shaped by the UNHR. After that, he talked on India's contribution to global human rights efforts. He mentioned that fundamental rights of India are somewhat similar to international human rights but have some slight difference. Human rights are not mentioned in the Indian constitution; instead, we refer to them as fundamental rights, which are exclusive to Indian citizens. Then, using several examples, he went over each article of the Indian constitution that dealt with fundamental rights and how freedom, equality, and justice were applied in the country.
