REPORT ON COLLEGE UNION ELECTION

Like almost in every college, our college - The Sree Narayana College, Nattika, Thrissur conducted the student union elections for the year 2023-24 on 1st November 2023.

The elections were held on the 1st November, after the admissions for first year PG & UG were over. As per the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala WPC No. 27085 of 2016, the election to the College was conducted in Parliamentary mode. The main objective of the election was the formation of our Students Union who will manage the affairs of the Union under the guidance and supervision of the Principal and other senior officials affiliated to our college. Smt. Praveena Vijayan, HOD. Department of Commerce was appointed as Returning Officer for the conduct of College Union election 2023. A committee was constituted including teaching and non-teaching faculties in the Department of Chemistry, IQAC coordinator – Dr. K.K. Sankaran and Dr. Anabha E R, Head of the Department of Chemistry. All heads of various departments were also equally responsible for the smooth conduct of College Union Election.

As per schedule given by the University of Calicut, the Returning Officer issued the notice for College Union Election 2023 and published the Preliminary Electoral roll on 10/10/2023. The final Electoral Roll was published in the notice board on 12/10/ 2022 at 3.00 pm and conducted a meeting of student representatives for giving directions and awareness of Parliamentary mode of election in our college.

On 27/10/2022 the returning officer issued a notice to file nominations for the various offices of our Student's Union in the parent departments. The last date for receiving nominations 17/10/2023. The scrutiny of nominations was done in the respective departments and the final list of valid nominations and all the nominations received by the departments were forwarded to the Returning Officer. The returning officer published the list of valid nominations on 17/10/2023 at 4.30 pm. The candidates were given time to rethink about their nominations and to withdraw nominations if necessary and published the final list of nominations on 18/10/2023 at 3.00 pm. The date of election was fixed on 1st November 2023. The committee arranged all the facilities for College Union election on 1/11/2023; meetings of nominated candidates as well as general body of teachers and non-teaching staffs were conducted. The committee printed ballot papers and other

documents and arranged all the facilities including ballot boxes and compartments for election.

The election was conducted in two phases. In Phase I class representatives were elected. Total of 72 representatives were elected on 1st November 2023. The elected candidate pass was issued to the elected candidates and were assembled in the examination hall at 11.30 am. All the teachers and selected members of non-teaching staffs were given duties for the smooth conduct of College Union Election. In the second phase, nominations from electoral College Union were received and conducted the election for office bearers, association secretaries and UG and PG representatives. The final list of elected college Union was declared in the same day by the Returning Officer. The oath taking ceremony was conducted on 17th November 2023.

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3. Arts Festival

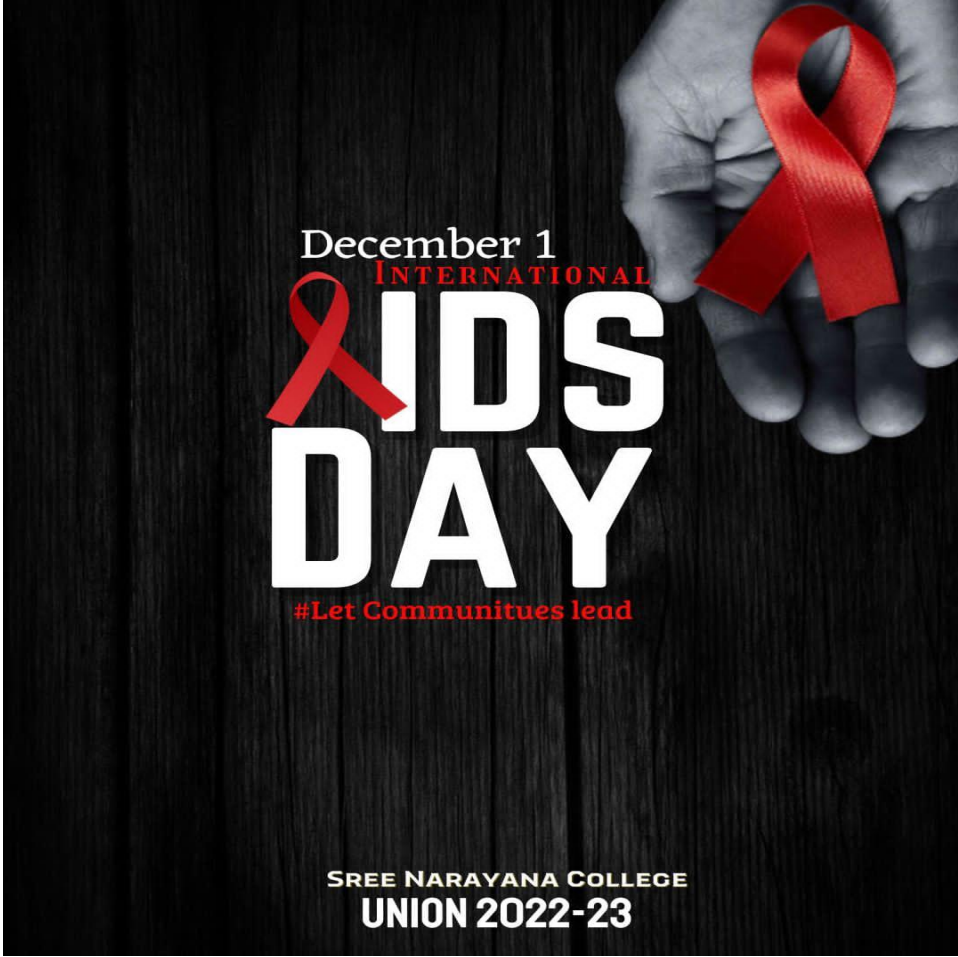

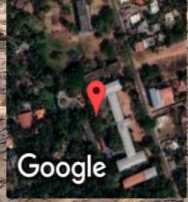
